<u>District 6 Happenings</u>: City Council District 6 representative Jackie Cole the budget process will be taking place starting August 5 with a public hearing on September 12 and adopting the budget September 19. The City plans a tax increase of 2 cents where the proceeds will be used mainly for public safety and fire. This will mean for a \$60,000 house; the increase will be \$60 if it is homesteaded. If not, the increase will be \$120.

<u>TxDot:</u> <u>Joel Clarke</u> – Assistant Area Engineer – provided a slide presentation of the proposed repaving and elevation of FM 3005. The elevation will be 7.5 feet above sea level so areas greater than this level will receive only a 1.5-inch overlay. Areas less than 7.5 feet above sea level will be raised.
