4 Mayoral Candidates

Please introduce yourself and state why you are campaigning to be Mayor. (3 min each)

- Many on the West End are concerned about the city services provided vs other parts of the City. The condition of our streets, infrastructure, drainage, police patrol for holidays have been continuing problems for years. Please provide your ideas regarding West End services and identify your priorities for the West End if you are elected Mayor. (3.0 min each)
- There are ongoing issues with the condition of the beach public access areas with many eroded/damaged causing property owners and visitors to use alternate paths to the beach, thereby destroying the dunes. Please tell us your plans to address this issue including the overcrowding in the subdivisions due to more public visitors with the implementation of Seawall parking. (3.0 min each)
- Please assess the financial sustainability of the city and your approach to controlling the increase in future tax rates while still delivering the services needed to the West End. With the West End being approximately 50 % of the tax base of Galveston, what % of the Capital Improvement Plan each year do you think should be targeted for the West End? (3.0 min each)
